EDGE– Sacred Heart Middle School Formation

EDGE is a Catholic middle School youth ministry and catechesis formation that:

- Provides a safe & fun place for youth to find solid Catholic community
- Answers questions about their faith
- Builds a foundation of faith that will guide them as they face difficulties and guide them as they make decisions that affect the rest of their middle school and high school years
- Helps youth to experience Jesus in a profound and personal way

EDGE SCHEDULE

All students in grades 6-8 will begin select Sunday evenings with Mass at 5:00pm. We would like the youth to sit together but they are more than welcome to sit with their family. **Attendance will be taken in the Gathering Space prior to each mass.**

*If attending a different mass with family or as part of ministry (Altar server, Tech Ministry) please communicate with RE. **The Mass connects our youth to what they are learning in EDGE.**

5:00pm	EDGE: begins with Mass
6:00pm	PROCLAIM: begins with upbeat music (Theme song(s) for the year) and Gospel reflection
6:20pm	Break: Begins with students going to small groups with Core Team for the lesson. Some EDGE nights may have a speaker or special activity. Possibilities are endless.....
7:15pm	SEND: Youth come back together to recap the evening. They are also given a challenge for the week that relates to the lesson or Gospel and are updated on service and parish opportunities.
7:30pm	Parent Pick-up

RETREATS: It is the expectation of the Pastor, Director and the Archdiocese of Detroit that Confirmation Prep youth experience a retreat every year.

A retreat refreshes and revitalizes, gives the opportunity for more time spent in prayer and contemplation, and rekindles and deepens one's relationship with God. One may take this opportunity to more clearly hear God's call and to seek God's healing grace and thereby attain a degree of spiritual renewal.

If a retreat date offered creates a scheduling conflict, it is up to the parent to seek other options in other Vicariates.

This year, Sacred Heart will offer a Vicariate Retreat for our EDGE youth on Sunday, March 6th 1:00pm to 6:00pm. This will include lunch and Mass.

The Second Vicariate option will be held on Sunday, March 3rd at Our Lady of the Woods. 1:00pm to 6:00pm.

NEW FAMILY CATECHESIS PROGRAM FOR GRADES PRE-K through 5

Beginning in the 2021 - 2022 school year, we are adding a Family Catechesis Program for families with children in grades Pre K through 5th.

WHAT: Family Catechesis is developed for the entire family to Encounter, Grow and Witness in their faith. The family will have age appropriate books to work on at home and we will meet once a month in person for a meal, catechesis on specific church topics, review of work-at-home chapters, fun and fellowship.

WHEN: Families enrolled will meet in person on select Sundays each month from 3:00pm until 5:00pm. We will begin with a meal together (for example, pizza, spaghetti, tacos), have the family lesson, take a break, review the weekly lesson and be finished by 5:00pm so we can attend Mass together with our EDGE youth.

WHERE: We will meet in the Parish Hall.

HOW: This program is NOT an at-home study program, but will replace the regular Sunday or Monday class sessions. If a student is in a Sacrament year (2nd or 4th grade), all prep sessions and retreats will be done as normal with the grade level class. Most prep sessions are scheduled on weekends. A retreat for 5th grade will be scheduled as well.

TUITION: Tuition is \$100 per family and an additional \$25 per child for books and materials. Grade 2 add \$50 per student. Grades 4 and 5 add \$30 per student.

WHY: Families have shown an interest to learn, along with their children, about our faith. The program allows for parents to become so strong in their own faith and knowledge that they naturally share the faith with their children and bring the faith into their family's everyday moments. The challenge presented to parents is for them to live the faith, even behind closed doors at home, day in and day out, in a dynamic, believing kind of way so that their kids would "catch it" from them. In addition, the monthly lessons at church supports their efforts and further equips them as parents to pass it on in the most effective way possible.

GOAL: Help families learn how to pray and to discuss their faith together.
Help parents better understand their role as primary catechists.
Bring families together for Mass and class in order to share and deepen their Catholic faith.
Strengthen the relationship between the family and the Church.
Establish ongoing Catholic faith practices within the family life.
